This book has been written specifically for anyone who is looking to break into the Australian aviation industry as a pilot. Whether just thinking about a career, part way through flight training or ready to look for that first job, this book covers everything you will need to know about this topic. Until now, most of this has been a well-kept secret. Recent regular publicity about the worldwide shortage of pilots has tempted a lot of people with an interest in aviation to contemplate a career as a pilot. They see seasoned captains in the major airlines earning big dollars and think that could be them in a few short years. Unfortunately, the reality is generally somewhat different. These potential pilots might go along to an information seminar held by a flight training organisation to find out more. Unfortunately, they will often be told what they want to hear, which is usually a long way from the truth. Or on the opposite end of the scale they might find a school that tells it how it is, then decide to give up because it sounds too hard. Until now, not only has it been difficult to find reliable information, but most of the aviation training industry does not recognise where the fundamental training problems lie. There can be a massive abyss between what a pilot learns on the way to the Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL), and what the industry needs a pilot to be able to do from day one. This results in a large percentage of newly graduated pilots, despite investing well over \$100,000 in their training, never being able to find their first job in aviation. This book investigates and analyses the problems in the Australian aviation industry that will affect trainee pilots and provides practical advice on how to deal with each of these. The end result is hopefully a well-informed student who will have a much greater chance of securing that often elusive first job in aviation.
